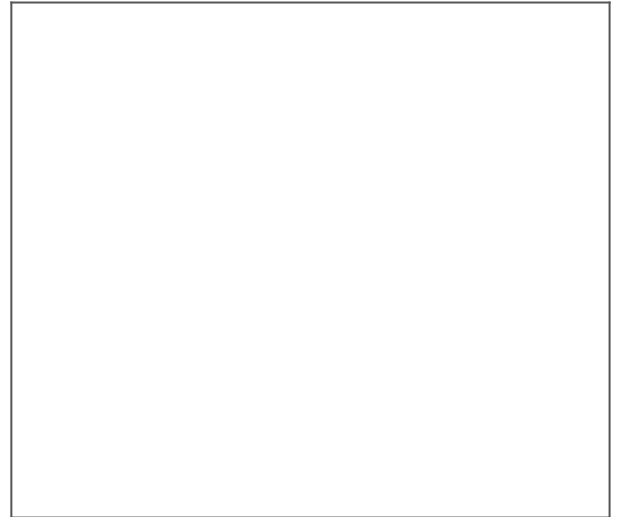


Adrian B. Frost Recognized as One of the Leading Lawyers Under 40 in Canada
