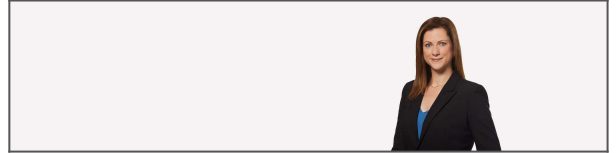


Lynda Troup Elected as 100th President of The Law Society of Manitoba
