

## **TDS Law Announces the Admission of Three Lawyers to the Partnership**

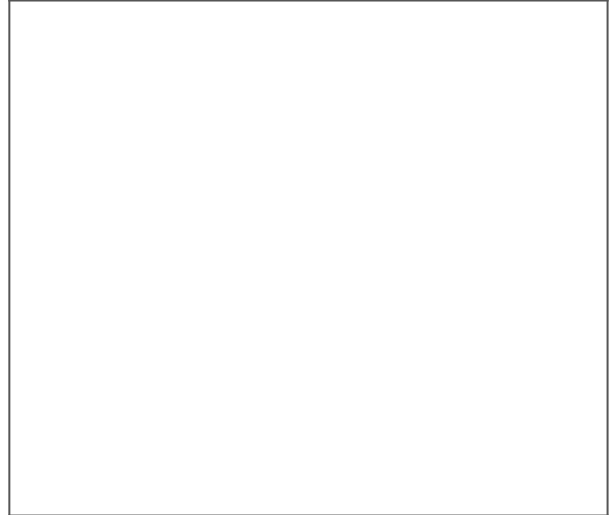
