

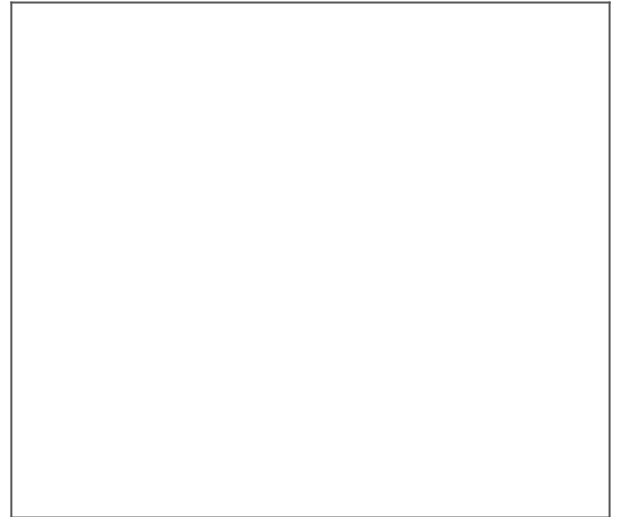
TDS Supports The Winnipeg Foundation's Program: Philanthropy & The Law Symposium
