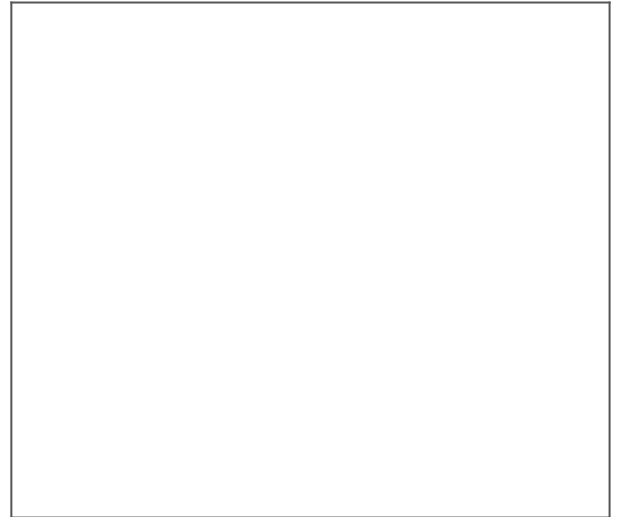


Thompson Dorfman Sweatman LLP (TDS Law) Celebrates 125 Years in the Community
