

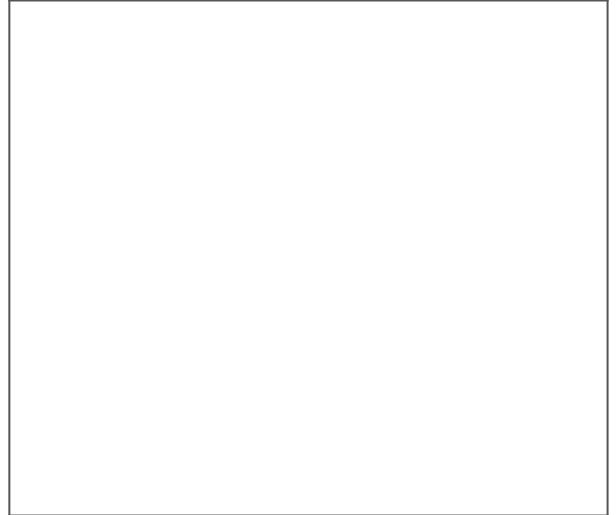
Winnipeg Lawyers of the Year
